Vocation Office – Main Events

Event	Date	Desc
Castle Nights	Monthly on the 3 rd Wednesday of the month during the school year	For HS guys – dinner, vespers, talk by a seminarian, and evening with the guys. Held at Brute Seminary. Works best if you can bring the young men yourself (w/ chaperones as needed) and stay the evening
Family Vocations Day	Saturday in January	Religious orders present in the Archdiocese are invited to the Catholic Center to host a table and activity. Families from the Archdiocese (including young children) are invited and make their way around the tables. Mass for all at noon in the cathedral.
Ordination Day Breakfast	First Saturday in June	An opportunity for men in application for seminary and those who are close to that stage to join seminarians and some priests for breakfast in the Catholic Center before ordinations at 10am in the cathedral.
Brute Days	July – 3 days	3 day camp held at Brute Seminary. Opportunity for high school guys from across the Archdiocese to get together and learn more about priesthood, discernment, etc. Field trip involved.
Brute Days Jr	July – 1 day	Same as above but only one day. Middle school boys. This year it will be held the day before the high school version.
Day of Prayer w/ St. John Vianney	August 4	Mass at noon in the Cathedral followed by Eucharistic Adoration until 5:00pm with Solemn Vespers at 4:30pm. Relic of SJV.
Soccer Tournament	Saturday in September	Hosted at Brute Seminary, high school and middle school teams from across the Archdiocese come to play soccer. There is a seminarian team in the tournament as well. The event concludes with a Mass.
Climb the Hill	Weekend in October	For college guys and recently graduated college guys – a weekend retreat at St. Meinrad w/ seminarians and vocation directors
St. Andrew Dinner	Early December	Priests invite a young man or a few to a nice dinner at Brute (high school and older). Fairly formal. Priests join for the evening.
